# Our CSR Policy

## **Objective**

- This CSR Policy is formulated in alignment with the provisions of Section 135 of the Companies Act, 2013 (the "Act") and the Companies (Corporate Social Responsibility Policy) Rules, 2014, as notified by the Ministry of Corporate Affairs through its notification dated February 27, 2014, and as amended from time to time.
- The primary objective of this policy is to establish a structured approach for the Company to undertake its CSR obligations. It aims to define the types of activities and programs to be implemented, along with the mechanisms for their execution, monitoring, and evaluation.
- This policy shall be applicable to all CSR initiatives undertaken by the Company across its locations, including its manufacturing units and operational centers, with the aim of benefiting various sections of society.

## **CSR Framework under the Companies Act, 2013**

In India, CSR is governed by Section 135 of the Companies Act, 2013, which came into effect from the financial year 2014–15. The Act mandates eligible companies to allocate at least 2% of their average net profits earned during the three immediately preceding financial years towards CSR activities, as prescribed under Schedule VII of the Act.

## Programs & Projects

### Focus Areas for CSR Projects and Programs

Rajsha Chemicals, as part of the TWC Group, undertakes CSR projects in alignment with the following thrust areas as outlined in Schedule VII of the Act:

- **Eradicating Hunger & Promoting Health:** Initiatives focused on eradicating hunger, poverty, and malnutrition; improving healthcare (including preventive care); and enhancing sanitation (including contributions to the Swachh Bharat Kosh).
- **Education & Skill Development:** Supporting education, including special education and vocational training, especially for children, women, the elderly, the differently-abled, and underprivileged communities.
- **Women Empowerment & Social Welfare:** Promoting gender equality, empowering women, establishing shelter homes for women and orphans, creating facilities for senior citizens, and supporting socially and economically disadvantaged groups.
- **Environmental Sustainability:** Projects aimed at environmental protection, ecological balance, wildlife preservation, agroforestry, conservation of natural resources, and maintaining air, water, and soil quality (including contributions to the Clean Ganga Fund).
- **Cultural & National Heritage Preservation:** Restoration and preservation of heritage sites and monuments, promotion of arts and culture, and support for public libraries and traditional handicrafts.
- **Support for Armed Forces:** Assistance for veterans, war widows, and their families.
- **Sports Promotion:** Encouraging rural and national sports, including Paralympic and Olympic sports.
- **Disaster Relief:** Contribution to the Prime Minister's National Relief Fund, PM CARES Fund, or similar government-established funds for socioeconomic development and emergency relief for marginalized groups.
- **Scientific Research & Innovation:** Contributions to government-funded R&D initiatives in science, technology, engineering, and medicine, including those carried out by IITs, national laboratories, and autonomous institutions like DRDO, ICAR, CSIR, and others engaged in advancing Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs).
- **Rural & Urban Development:** Infrastructure and livelihood projects in rural and slum areas aimed at overall community development.

- **Disaster Management:** Programs related to disaster preparedness, relief, rehabilitation, and reconstruction efforts.
- **Other Permissible Activities:** Any additional CSR activity approved by the Board of Directors upon recommendation by the CSR Committee, in line with the provisions of Section 135 and Schedule VII of the Companies Act, 2013.

### **Guidelines for Implementation**

- CSR initiatives will be identified and approved by the CSR Committee, with preference given to the local communities and regions where the Company operates.
- CSR activities will be distinct from the Company's routine business operations and will not be considered as part of normal business activity.
- Any CSR initiative or program that solely benefits the Company's employees will not qualify as CSR under the Act.
- Any surplus generated from CSR initiatives shall be reinvested into CSR activities and will not be added to the business profits of the Company.
- All CSR initiatives shall comply with applicable rules, notifications, and circulars issued by the Ministry of Corporate Affairs from time to time.

## CSR Governance Structure

### Corporate Social Responsibility (CSR) Committee – Constitution & Responsibilities

In accordance with Section 135 of the Companies Act, 2013, the Board of Directors of the Company shall constitute a **Corporate Social Responsibility (CSR) Committee** comprising three or more directors.

#### Current Composition of the CSR Committee:

1. **Mr. Sushil K. Agarwal** – Chairman
2. **Mr. Ashish Agarwal** – Member
3. **Mrs. Pooja Agarwal** – Member

#### Key Responsibilities of the CSR Committee

The CSR Committee shall be entrusted with the following roles and responsibilities:

##### 1. Policy Formulation:

Develop and recommend the CSR Policy to the Board, outlining the activities to be undertaken by the Company in accordance with Schedule VII of the Companies Act, 2013.

##### 2. Budget Recommendations:

Propose the annual financial allocation for CSR activities to the Board.

##### 3. Annual Action Plan:

Formulate and recommend an annual CSR action plan, which shall include:

A list of approved CSR projects and programs in alignment with Schedule VII of the Act.

- Execution methodology as per Rule 4(1) of the CSR Rules.
- Detailed budget utilization strategies and implementation timelines.
- A robust monitoring and reporting framework.

- Assessment of needs and expected impacts of CSR initiatives.
- Recommendations for modifications to the action plan, if necessary, with justifications.

#### 4. **Monitoring & Oversight:**

Oversee the implementation and progress of the CSR Policy and ensure that projects are carried out as approved by the Board.

#### 5. **Guidance & Strategic Direction:**

Define the overall direction for CSR activities and establish guiding principles for:

- Selection and prioritization of CSR projects and programs.
- Effective execution and management of approved initiatives.

### **Board Responsibilities & Disclosure**

- The Board shall review and approve the CSR Policy and the recommendations made by the CSR Committee.
- The approved CSR Policy, along with the annual action plan, shall be:
  - Disclosed in the Company's Board Report, in accordance with the Companies Act.
  - Published on the Company's official website to ensure transparency and accountability.
- The Board shall also ensure that the Company undertakes all CSR activities as outlined in its approved CSR Policy.

### **Monitoring, Implementation & Reporting**

- The implementation of CSR initiatives will be carried out either directly by the Company or through registered implementing partners, as per the prescribed guidelines.

- Monitoring mechanisms will be put in place to track project progress, fund utilization, and overall impact.
- The Company shall report its CSR activities annually in its Board Report, in compliance with Section 135 of the Companies Act, 2013 and the corresponding rules.

## **Corporate Social Responsibility (CSR) Budget**

### **1. Budget Allocation**

The Company shall allocate an annual CSR budget equivalent to **2% of the average net profits before tax** of the three immediately preceding financial years, in accordance with Section 135 of the Companies Act, 2013.

### **2. Budget Review and Recommendation**

The Board shall annually review and recommend budget allocations across the Company's defined focus areas. These recommendations will form part of the annual action plan submitted for Board approval.

### **3. Treatment of Surplus from CSR Activities**

- Any income, surplus, or gains arising from CSR initiatives shall not be treated as business profits of the Company.
- Such surplus shall be:
  - Reinvested into the same project, or
  - Transferred to the Unspent CSR Account and utilized in accordance with the CSR Policy and Annual Action Plan, or
  - Transferred to a fund specified in Schedule VII of the Act within six months from the end of the relevant financial year.

### **4. Fund Management and Segregation**

- The allocated CSR funds may be segregated from general corporate finances and maintained in a dedicated bank account, to be utilized exclusively for CSR purposes.

### **5. Treatment of Excess Spending**

- If the Company spends more than the amount mandated under Section 135(5), such excess may be carried forward and adjusted against CSR obligations for the next three consecutive financial years, provided that:
  - The excess does not include any surplus arising from CSR activities as defined under Rule 7(2).
  - The Board passes a formal resolution authorizing such set-off.

## **6. Capital Asset Creation or Acquisition**

CSR funds may be utilized for the creation or acquisition of capital assets, provided that such assets are held by:

- a. A Section 8 company, a Registered Trust, or a Registered Society with charitable objectives and a valid CSR Registration Number,
- b. Beneficiaries of the CSR project, such as self-help groups, collectives, or similar entities, or
- c. A public authority, as defined under applicable laws.

## **7. Oversight and Certification**

- All CSR expenditures shall be pre-approved by the CSR Committee.
- The Board shall ensure that funds disbursed are used exclusively for the approved CSR purposes.
- The Chief Financial Officer (CFO) or the designated officer responsible for financial management shall certify the utilization of CSR funds in accordance with the CSR Policy and the Companies Act.

## **8. Transfer of Unspent CSR Amounts**

- In cases where a specific fund under Schedule VII has not been identified for the purposes of Section 135(5) and (6), any unspent CSR amount shall be transferred to any fund listed in Schedule VII of the Companies Act, 2013, within the stipulated time frame.

### **Annual CSR Action Plan**

The CSR Committee shall be responsible for preparing and recommending an Annual Action Plan to the Board of Directors. This plan will serve as a strategic roadmap for the Company's CSR initiatives for the financial year and shall include the following components:

- a. A comprehensive list of CSR projects or programs proposed to be undertaken, aligned with the thematic areas specified in Schedule VII of the Companies Act, 2013;
- b. The execution methodology for each project or program, as outlined under Rule 4(1) of the Companies (CSR Policy) Rules;
- c. Detailed information on fund utilization mechanisms and clearly defined implementation timelines for each initiative;
- d. A structured monitoring and reporting framework to track the progress and outcomes of the CSR activities;
- e. Where applicable, documentation of need assessments and impact evaluations conducted for the approved projects.

The Board of Directors retains the authority to revise or amend the Annual Action Plan during the course of the financial year, based on the recommendations of the CSR Committee. Any such modifications shall be supported by a reasonable justification and duly documented.

## CSR Reporting and Compliance

In the event that the Company is unable to expend the allocated CSR funds within the stipulated timeframe, the Board of Directors shall disclose the reasons for such non-expenditure in the Board's report, pursuant to clause (o) of sub-section (3) of Section 134 of the Companies Act, 2013.

- If the unspent amount does not pertain to any ongoing project, it shall be transferred to a fund specified under Schedule VII of the Act within six months from the end of the financial year.
- However, if the unspent amount relates to an ongoing project, the Company shall open a separate bank account—termed the 'Unspent CSR Account'—within 30 days from the close of the financial year. The unspent funds must be utilized within a period of three financial years from the date of transfer. If the amount remains unspent after this period, it must be transferred to a Schedule VII fund within 30 days of the completion of the third financial year.

### Definition of Ongoing Project:

An ongoing project is defined as a multi-year CSR initiative undertaken to fulfill the Company's CSR obligations, with a maximum duration of three years (excluding the year of commencement). This definition also encompasses projects that were initially not approved as multi-year projects but whose timelines have been extended beyond one year by the Board on reasonable grounds.

## Disclosure and Impact Assessment

- The Company shall report its CSR activities in the prescribed format within the Directors' Report and make the details available on the Company's official website.
- Where the Company's average CSR expenditure in the preceding three financial years reaches or exceeds ₹10 crore, it is required to conduct an impact assessment of CSR projects with a budget of ₹1 crore or more. This assessment must be performed by an independent agency and cover projects completed at least one year prior to the assessment.

- The impact assessment report shall be presented to the Board and annexed to the Annual CSR Report.
- The Company shall also ensure public disclosure of the CSR Committee composition, the CSR Policy, and the list of CSR projects approved by the Board on its website for transparency.

### **Authority and Amendments**

- This CSR Policy has been formally approved by the Board of Directors based on the recommendations of the CSR Committee.
- The CSR Committee will periodically review the Policy in light of evolving beneficiary needs and organizational objectives, proposing amendments as necessary.
- Any modifications or amendments to this Policy shall be subject to approval by the Board of Directors.

This Policy shall be effective from **1st April 2022**.

- **14-Dec-24: Shree Ram Janki Pariwar Seva Trust**

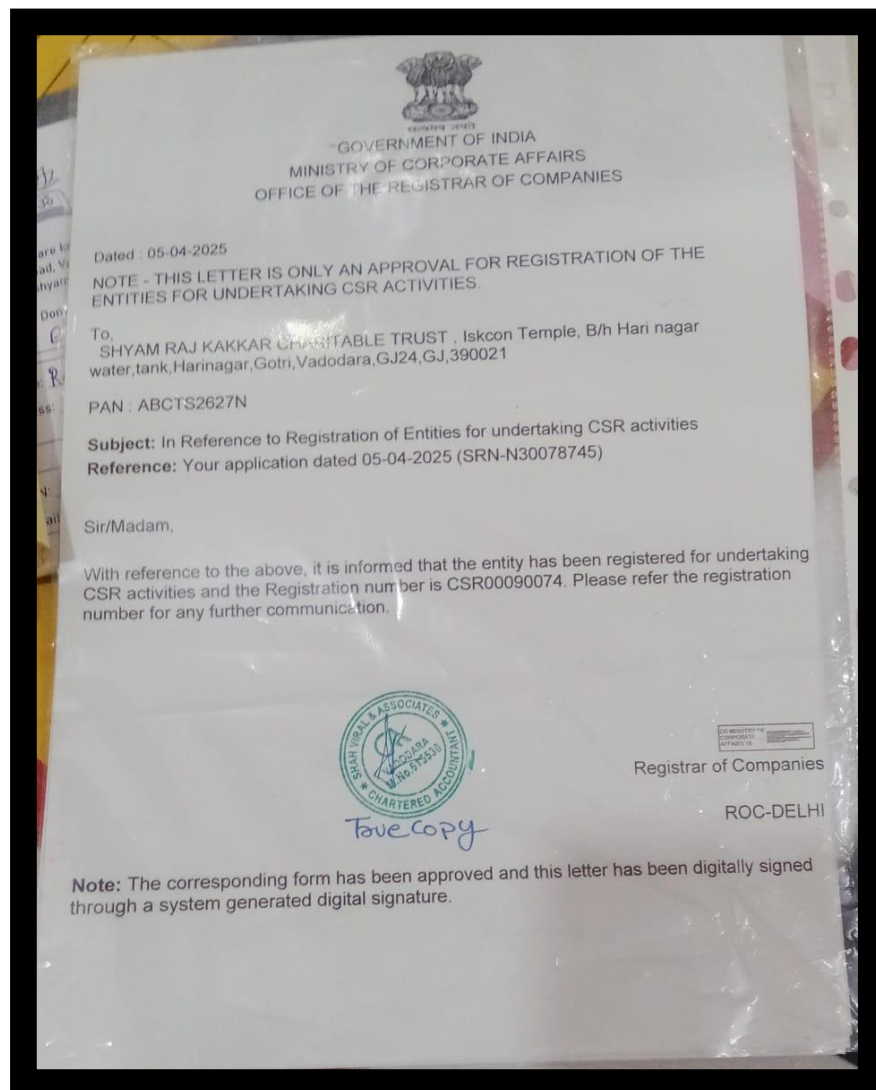

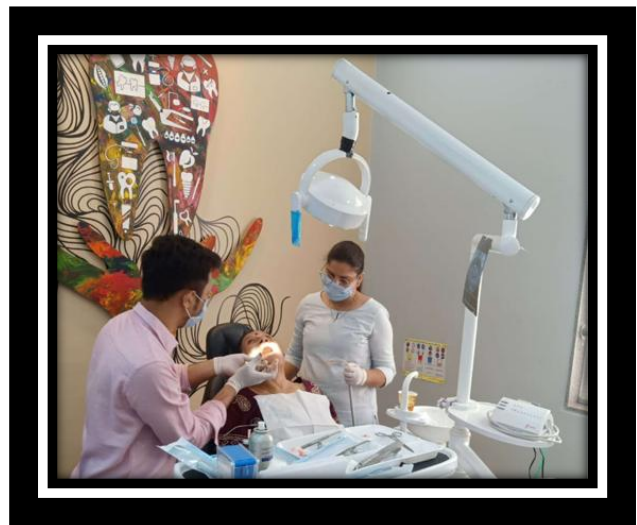
- **18-Mar-25: RAGINIBEN BIPINCHANDRA SEVA KARYA TRUST**


